## Frequently Asked Questions

#### Q. I'm a beginner, where should I start?

A. For absolute beginners, we recommend starting with our Mango Conversations courses. These are our core courses which have the most content, and assume no prior knowledge of the language.

## Q. Do I have to go to the library to use Mango?

Q. The library is an awesome place, but you don't have to go there to use Mango! Library users can access Mango from any computer with an internet connection. Simply go to **tscpl.org/mango** to learn from the comfort of your home.

You can also study with us anywhere you go using the free Mango Languages mobile app on your phone or tablet.

## Q. How long does it take to learn a new language with Mango?

A. Mango Languages is completely self-paced and the amount of time it takes to build fluency will depend on the learner as well as the language that person is learning. Most learners take about 20-40 minutes to complete one lesson, and approximately 3 months of daily study to complete a Unit.

#### Q. Can I learn more than one language?

A. At Mango we love learning languages, so we couldn't possibly limit you to just one! Feel free to study languages without limits, and learn as many as your heart desires.
